Brothers and Sisters in this month's Chaplain Corner I would like to talk briefly about Suicide Prevention and Intervention.

September is Suicide Prevention month, and we are currently losing 22 veterans every single day in all services, and this is an issue that everyone can get involved in. If a veteran or active-duty member comes to you and tells you that they are having suicide thoughts, they are reaching out to you. Don't dismiss them, talk with them to see if you can help them. It can be as simple as listening to them. Don't be afraid to reach out and help someone who is struggling OR reach out for help if you are struggling God won't ever let you go, and he has given others in life to help you shoulder you this burden. Many of us have been down this road before so you are not alone, my brothers and sisters. Suicide is not age discriminatory it affects people of all ages and races and even children commit suicide as well. Suicide is not a modern phenomenon. The Bible mentions several instances of suicide. The Bible says that Judas, the disciple who betrayed Jesus, hung himself when he couldn't bear the terrible guilt he felt for aiding in the arrest and crucifixion of Jesus (See Matthew 27:5). Another example is King Saul, the first king of Israel. Saul fell on his own sword during battle when it was apparent that he had lost the battle and he would be captured, tortured, and killed by his enemies (I Samuel 31:4).

I would like to close this month Chaplain Corner with this prayer:

1 John 5:14-15

Oh, Precious Lord, Your Word states that I can have confidence in You, so that if I ask anything according to Your will, You hear me and if I know that You hear me in whatever I ask, I know that I have the requests I have asked of You. I am crying out to you right now in hopes that you will change the mindset of my loved one, I pray against suicidal thoughts in Jesus' Name, Amen.

Remember that it talks only one person to prevent someone from taking their own life. Be that person to help a fellow brother or sister. God Bless you all.
